10. John 8:31-32

22. Matthew 4:4

Why can't we live on bread alone?
What "sustenance" does the Word of God provide that bread does not?

23. Proverbs 21:5

How does this verse relate to being patient?

24. Matthew 7:24

Why does knowledge in the Word make you like the wise man?
What characteristics would a foolish man have? Which one are you?

25. James 4:17

If we know what is right and good, why do you think it is so hard for us to do what is right?

26. 1 Samuel 15:22

In the Old Testament they would sacrifice animals to honor God. What sacrifices can you make in your own life today?
